- <sup>108</sup> Accept, LORD, the willing praise of my mouth, and teach me your laws.
- <sup>109</sup> Though I constantly take my life in my hands, I will not forget your law.
- <sup>110</sup>The wicked have set a snare for me, but I have not strayed from your precepts.
- 111 Your statutes are my heritage for ever; they are the joy of my heart.
- 112 My heart is set on keeping your decrees to the very end-

## Matthew 4:1-11

- 4 Then Jesus was led by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted<sup>1</sup> by the devil. <sup>2</sup> After fasting for forty days and forty nights, he was hungry. <sup>3</sup> The tempter came to him and said, 'If you are the Son of God, tell these stones to become bread.' <sup>4</sup> Jesus answered, 'It is written: "Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God' <sup>5</sup> Then the devil took him to the holy city and set him on the highest point of the temple. <sup>6</sup> 'If you are the Son of God,' he said, 'throw yourself down. For it is written:
- "He will command his angels concerning you, and they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone."
- <sup>7</sup> Jesus answered him, 'It is also written: "Do not put the Lord your God to the test. <sup>8</sup> Again, the devil took him to a very high mountain and showed him all the kingdoms of the world and their splendour. <sup>9</sup> 'All this I will give you,' he said, 'if you will bow down and worship me.' <sup>10</sup> Jesus said to him, 'Away from me, Satan! For it is written: "Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only' <sup>11</sup> Then the devil left him, and angels came and attended him.
