St. John's Council & Volunteers

Parochial Church Council (PCC)


St. John's, Stoneleigh A Proud History

The roots of St. John's can be traced back to the consecration of the building in May 1939, with the Parish of Stoneleigh being constituted in 1948 to meet the needs of a growing population in the area. However, the seeds of community and worship were sown even earlier.

In 1935, a Sunday school took root at Sparrow Farm School (now Meadow Primary). A year later, in 1936, the Church opened its doors in a hall in Dell Lane, becoming a sacred space where regular services echoed with prayers and hymns.

The cornerstone of our present spiritual abode was laid in 1938. Over the years, the structure has evolved. In 1958, the Church witnessed expansion with the addition of the tower, gallery, and porch. Technological enhancements arrived in 1998 with the installation of a hearing loop system and sound system, enriching the worship experience.

In the years 2000 and 2012, the Church underwent physical transformations. In 2000, the glass doors at the west end were installed, a memorial to a cherished member of the congregation, welcoming both light and reverence.



In 2012, the Open Doors project saw the removal of the choir pews and an enlarged dais was built with a new Communion table that enabled the Eucharist to be taken at the Chancel steps. Glass doors were also fitted at the north entrance.

While the red brick exterior stands as a testament to time, the interior of St. John's unfolds in beauty and simplicity. The Chapel on the north side, a haven for services and private prayer, echoes with the whispers of devotion.

Further technological advancements were made in 2021 with the addition of large screens and a sound desk which provide great flexibility in worship, especially for the contemporary service with its worship band and use of visual imagery.

The soul-stirring notes of the original pipe organ, that was refurbished in 2022 through the generosity of the Pavey Family, resonate through the Church, adding a musical layer to our worship.

The Parish Centre became an integral part of our story in 1995. With its excellent facilities, it weaves connections within the Church and extends its influence into the wider community here in Stoneleigh. As we walk through the chapters of our history, St. John's Stoneleigh stands as more than a physical space; it's a living narrative of faith, growth, family, and community.

There's no need to book – just come along


What to Expect:

Baptisms at St John's Embracing New Beginnings

What is Baptism?

Baptism (also called christening) is a beautiful sacrament; a visible and public sign of an inner commitment to start following Jesus on a life journey of faith in response to His love for us. If the one being baptised is an infant, then parents and godparents make a commitment to raise the child in the knowledge of God's love and guide them to follow Jesus as part of the Church. This ceremony marks a new beginning in the family of the Church, expressing gratitude for the gift of new life.



Who Can Be Baptized at St John's?

If you live in Stoneleigh parish, are a regular worshipper, or have a connection with St John's, we would be delighted to discuss baptism with you for you or your child.

The Baptism Service:

Baptisms take place during our regular 11:00am Sunday service. The Baptism ceremony involves the minister pouring water over the head to symbolise being washed clean to start a new life with Christ. A lighted candle, given at the end, symbolises Christ's love, as the light of the world and can be lit on each baptism anniversary. A bible is also offered as a gift to help people deepen their relationship with Jesus.

Godparents:

If you've been asked to be a godparent, congratulations! For parents choosing godparents, we're here to provide advice. There should be at least three godparents with both genders represented. Godparents must be baptised. If someone is not baptised, they can still be involved as a sponsor but the minimum number of godparents is still required.

How do I arrange a baptism?

Getting Married at St John's

The First Steps. If you dream of exchanging vows at St. John's, our team is here to support you. The initial step involves checking if your particular circumstances enable you to marry here. There are a number of legal checks and 'qualifying criteria' (see overleaf) which the Vicar will happily guide you through, ensuring you meet the necessary requirements.

Planning Your Special Day:

We will schedule an initial meeting with the Vicar. This meeting is an opportunity to discuss the practical aspects of the service and delve into the profound significance of marriage. Your unique love story will shape the ceremony, making it a meaningful and personal experience.

What does it cost to get married in church?

At time of publication, fees for a Church of England wedding are £531, not including extras such as bellringing, organist or flowers.

Marriage at St. John's Qualifying Connections

At St John's, we cherish the opportunity to be a part of your special day. To be married at St John's, you can meet the criteria if:

Living in the Parish:

If you reside in our parish, you are eligible.

Regular Worshipper:

If your name is on the electoral roll and you are a regular worshipper, you are warmly welcome.

Qualifying Connection:

You can establish a qualifying connection with the parish through the following:

- A. Baptism: If you were baptized in our parish (except in a combined rite including baptism and confirmation), or your confirmation is recorded in our register.
- B. Residence: If you had your usual place of residence in our parish for at least six months at any time.
- C. Attendance: If you have habitually attended public worship in our parish for a continuous period of not less than six months.
- D. Parent's Residence or Worship: If a parent had their usual place of residence in our parish for at least six months during your lifetime, or if a parent habitually attended public worship in our parish for that period.
- E. Parent or Grandparent's Marriage: If a parent or grandparent of yours was married in our parish.

Definitions:

Parent: Includes adoptive parents and individuals responsible for the care and upbringing of the person establishing a qualifying connection.

Grandparent: Includes the grandparents of the person seeking a qualifying connection.

The first step is to reach out to a funeral director. They will assist you in making arrangements and can coordinate with St John's for the funeral service. Whether you prefer a service in church or at a crematorium led by our Vicar, funeral directors will handle the initial coordination.

Direct Contact:

If you prefer, you are always welcome to contact us directly. St. John's is here to assist, especially if you have a connection to the parish or wish to discuss the service details.

Funeral Service in Church:

Our Vicar officiates at funerals for those who lived in the parish or have a connection to the church. We are here to provide support and ensure the service is a meaningful tribute to your loved one.

Annual Remembering Loved Ones Service:

Every year on the nearest Sunday to All Souls' Day (2 November), we hold a special service at St. John's. During this service, the names of departed loved ones are read out and remembered. It is a time for reflection and support. Keep an eye on our website or contact us for more details.
