The tradition of celebrating Harvest Festival in church is said to date back to 1843 at Morwenstow in Cornwall when the Rev Robert Hawker encouraged parishioners to bring produce to the church as a thanks offering.

This year, St John's will be celebrating Harvest with a service at 11:00am. We will be accepting donations of food\* to support the Epsom & Ewell Foodbank who last year distributed more than 10,000 emergency food parcels. The service will be followed by a Bring & Share lunch.

# Remembering Loved Ones Church Service

October 27th – 3:00pm

This is a poignant and reflective occasion dedicated to honouring and remembering those who have passed away. The service offers a space for individuals and families to come together before our loving God in grief, remembrance, and hope. There is an opportunity to light a candle in memoriam.

Remembering Loved Ones is open to all to attend, whether or not those who are being remembered professed any religious conviction or faith. There is a point during the service when names of the deceased are read aloud. If you are planning to attend, you may choose to have the name of your loved one read out if the information is received by the church office at least one week prior to the service.



# Remembrance Sunday Church Service

November 10th – 10:15am

---

Remembrance Sunday is a day dedicated to honouring the sacrifice of those who have died in wars, particularly in the two World Wars. This act of remembrance is not just a civic duty but a spiritual one, rooted in the teachings of Jesus Christ, who emphasized the greatest love as laying down one's life for others.

At a time when major conflicts continue to tear nations and communities apart, the Remembrance Day service prompts us to reflect on the importance of peace, reconciliation, and forgiveness.

Our service begins in the church and then moves to the Garden of Remembrance where the bugler will play the Last Post and we observe a two minute silence. Wreaths will be laid at the foot of the cross.

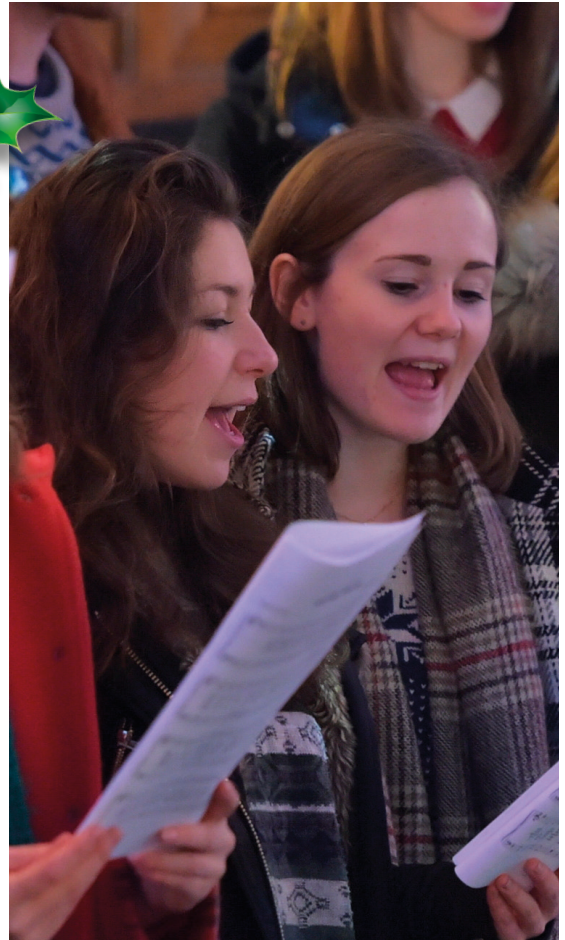


# Carols in The Station Pub

Our usual line up of Christmas services is extended in 2024 with an additional Crib and Christingle service. This has been such a popular event with families in recent years that we have decided to hold it twice. It will be the same service so choose the time that suits you best.

---

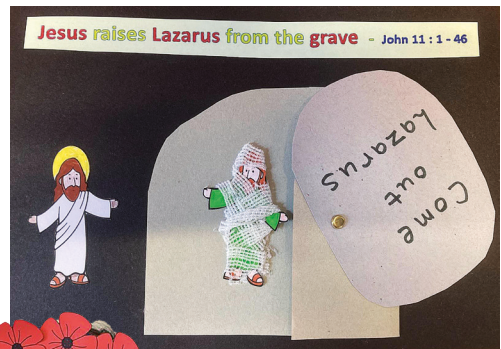
This is a more formal style of church service with Anglican Common Worship liturgy, traditional hymns and Holy Communion. The service lasts for an hour with refreshments served afterwards.

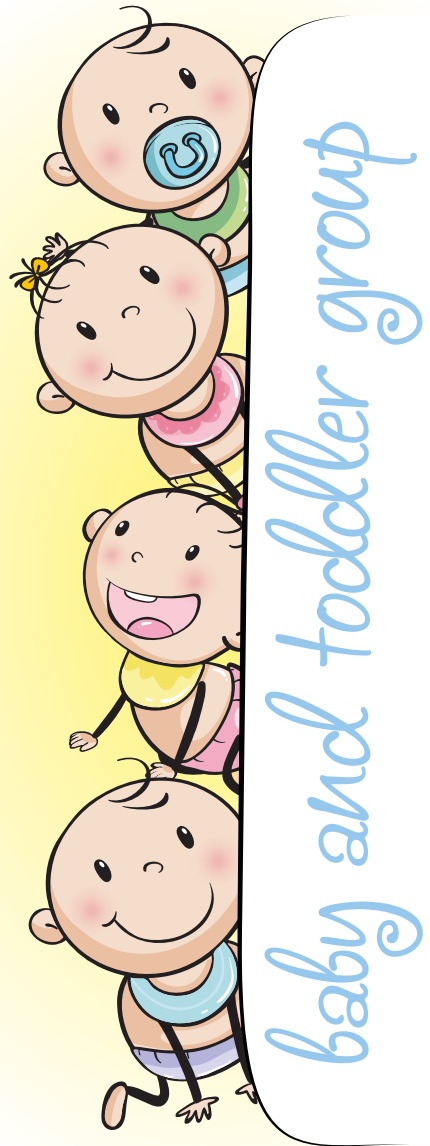
Materials are provided on Jan's craft table for brilliant craft activities each week.

Tunes'n'Tea is a musical and social community project that started in 2016 in St John's Parish Centre and, apart from the COVID period, has been running every month since. Therefore, we perform Pop, Rock, Jazz and Country Rock mostly and on the whole we select songs they are familiar with from the 1950's to the present day.

# Spotlight on... London All Nations Church

London All Nations Church is a Korean church established on October 1st, 2005, meeting at St John's Church. We are located about 15 minutes away from New Malden, the heart of the Korean community in the UK.

We are a small family-like community, built on faith and love while building up the kingdom of God. We have been growing in collaboration with St John's, transcending cultural and denominational differences. While our Korean Sunday service is held at 2:00pm, it is also a source of joy to be a part of the 11:00am service at St John's as it is not common to witness such cooperation between the Korean and English churches!



Since 2007, JB Park has been serving as the Senior Pastor, with his wife, Grace Jang. Their four children – Yea In, Yea Jin, Joshua, and Sharon – are British-Korean and are part of a generation of believers who love and bridge the two cultures and they aid their parents in their ministry.

We pray at 5:00am every morning, holding onto the hope that we play a 'small role' with 'big vision', that a great wave of revival will wash over the world starting here, through prayer, worship and mission.

**The First Steps.** If you dream of exchanging vows at St. John's, our team is here to support you. The initial step involves checking if your particular circumstances enable you to marry here. There are a number of legal checks and 'qualifying criteria' which the Vicar will happily guide you through, ensuring you meet the necessary requirements.



## Planning Your Special Day

We will schedule an initial meeting with the Vicar. This meeting is an opportunity to discuss the practical aspects of the service and delve into the profound significance of marriage. Your unique love story will shape the ceremony, making it a meaningful and personal experience.

## What does it cost to get married in church?

At time of publication, fees for a Church of England wedding are £531, not including extras such as bellringing, organist or flowers.

# Baptisms at St John's

## Embracing New Beginnings

---

### What is Baptism?

Baptism (also called christening) is a beautiful sacrament; a visible and public sign of an inner commitment to start following Jesus on a life journey of faith in response to His love for us. If the one being baptised is an infant, then parents and godparents make a commitment to raise the child in the knowledge of God's love and guide them to follow Jesus as part of the Church. This ceremony marks a new beginning in the family of the Church, expressing gratitude for the gift of new life.



### Who Can Be Baptized at St John's?

If you live in Stoneleigh parish, are a regular worshipper, or have a connection with St John's, we would be delighted to discuss baptism with you for you or your child.

### The Baptism Service

Baptisms take place during our regular 11:00am Sunday service. The Baptism ceremony involves the minister pouring water over the head to symbolise being washed clean to start a new life with Christ. A lighted candle, given at the end, symbolises Christ's love, as the light of the world and can be lit on each baptism anniversary. A bible is also offered as a gift to help people deepen their relationship with Jesus.

### Godparents

If you've been asked to be a godparent, congratulations! For parents choosing godparents, we're here to provide advice. There should be at least three godparents with both genders represented. Godparents must be baptised. If someone is not baptised, they can still be involved as a sponsor but the minimum number of godparents is still required.

### How do I arrange a baptism?

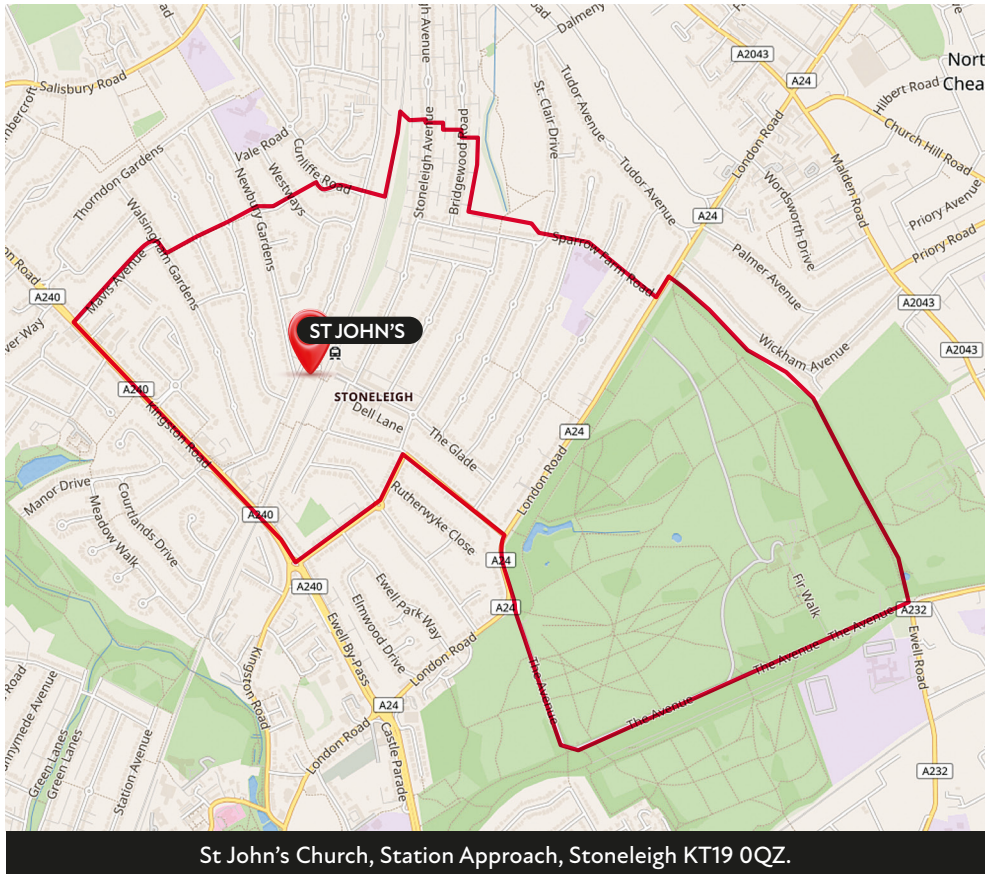

# Services & Worship at St John's

## Sunday Services
